About Our Church Community

Covenant Community Church is a place where we strive to celebrate God, connect with others and change the world. Our church community consists of roughly 120 members, who are some of the kindest people you will ever meet. We are authentic, committed believers who care deeply about growing as disciples of Jesus Christ through studying and applying God's word.

Our church community is multigenerational (ages infancy to 100!) with the next generation involved in ministries across the church – students serve significant roles in our weekly worship praise band, Sunday media team, children's ministry, and various service and outreach projects. In general, our church body is thriving, but we recognize the need to grow our ministry to children, students, young adults and their parents. We want to disciple our next generation well.

Our church campus is located on five acres of land and includes a sanctuary, a building for children's ministry, and a staff office building. We recently updated our sanctuary with a refreshed stage design, new flooring, and upgraded sound/video equipment. We use our facilities to serve our neighbors through events such as VBS and Trunk or Treat, and by hosting community groups and events on campus. We also partner with other local churches and ministries to care for those in need in our community and across the world.

About Our City and Surrounding Area

With a population of just over 100,000 residents spanning roughly 29 square miles, Vacaville was rated in the top 50 “most livable small cities” in the country in 2022 – and we highly agree with this assessment!

The growth of Vacaville over the past few years and the plans for further expansion are some of the many reasons that it is such a desirable place to live. Located in Solano County, the area is supported by a diversified economy that includes Travis Air Force Base, biotechnology, manufacturing, government, agriculture, and much more. The City of Vacaville has exciting plans to expand its world class biomanufacturing center by 300 acres. Our church is also eight minutes to the local Amtrak station for commutes to San Francisco and other Bay Area cities. We have the top-rated school district in the county as well as highly rated charter and private school options. Vacaville also sits between several amazing universities (UC Davis, UC Berkeley, Sonoma State and Sacramento State) and is home to Solano Community College. Finally, the residential area surrounding CCC is expanding with multiple new home communities, putting our church in a prime area for growth and outreach.

[Vacaville](#) residents enjoy the small-town charm and bountiful community events. It’s easy to spend an enjoyable day around the town. There’s hiking or biking around historic Vaca Peña and Lagoon Valley, shopping at the Vacaville Premium Outlets, or visiting the Nut Tree train and carousel followed by ice cream at Fentons Creamery. Throughout the year there are a plethora of events to attend at the city’s wonderful libraries, community centers, senior center and Performing Arts Theatre. The downtown and town square area hosts superb events including Restaurant Week, Fiesta Days, Creekwalk Concerts, Farmers’ Market, and Merriment on Main. At Christmas time, a stroll down our famous Candy Cane lane enjoying the incredible Christmas lights with a cup of hot cocoa is a must!

Vacaville is centrally located to almost anything you could imagine exploring in Northern California. To the west you can find San Francisco, the Napa/Sonoma wine country, world class dining, redwood forests, beaches and the Sacramento River Delta. To the east you can explore Lake Tahoe for skiing, snowboarding, hiking, kayaking, camping and mountain biking. And don’t forget about Yosemite National Park and the eclectic gold rush towns. The possibilities of fun days exploring not only Vacaville but all of Northern California are endless.
